

Safety Procedures



We're committed to a fun and safe environment for our campers and staff and have implemented many new practices and policies because of Covid-19. We expect to modify these as needed based on changes in guidelines from the Ontario and federal health ministry.

To adhere to provincial guidelines we will be running reduced size in-person camps this summer. We have 2 classrooms and each will have 4 students with 1 instructor, for a compliment of 10.

Training and Safety Procedures

- Staff have all been trained on proper health and safety practices
- Masks are other PPE provided to staff and campers are asked to bring a mask
- Day 1 includes a student lesson on Covid-19 safety procedures and practices at our Studio, which is followed by a quick review each day
- Signage has been placed around the studio to remind everyone of safe procedures

Check-In / Departure

- Only staff and registered campers are allowed in the facility at this time, thank you for understanding
- A staff member will welcome campers at the door, do a quick temperature check, record the name of the parent/guardian doing the drop-off
- Students will be asked to head straight to the washroom to wash their hands with soap and water; signage is posted in the washroom

Workstations

- Each camper will be assigned their own workstation consisting of a table, chair, computer/tablet, robotics, and other equipment relevant to the lesson/class
- Every morning and throughout the day equipment and wiped down
- During class sessions, students are asked to remain at their workstation

Breaks/Lunch

- Campers and staff will be asked to wash their hands at break and lunchtime
- Morning breaks, afternoon breaks, and lunch will be inside or outside depending on the weather with students asked to be mindful of distance to one another
- Lunch will be served outside at the baseball bleachers with campers spaced apart
- The Bishop Cross Park playground equipment is currently closed

Common Areas

- Common areas such as the washroom and lobby will be cleaned each morning and regularly throughout the day

Communication

- Communication plays an important role in fighting Covid-19.
- If any camper or staff member comes into contact with someone with Covid-19, we will notify parents and the York Region Health Services and follow the required protocol.
